

## COST/IRHT – TRAINING SCHOOL TRANSMISSION OF TEXTS: NEW TOOLS, NEW APPROACHES

#### 31 March - 4 April 2014

#### **REGISTRATION CONDITIONS AND PRE-REQUISITES**

**Level**: applicants must be students or researchers in history, literature, art history (doctoral candidates and post-doctoral researchers) specialized in medieval studies, who have already worked with medieval manuscripts. The number of places is limited to 20 and priority is given to persons coming from one of the 36 countries participating in COST Actions.

<u>Knowledge of Latin is required</u>. A fair knowledge of another ancient language(s) will be appreciated (Greek, Hebrew, medieval French).

Sessions will be conducted in **French** and **English**.

Material needs: a portable computer.

**Commitment**: Monday afternoon, each participant will informally present his or her research and its context, using a poster that has been assembled and labeled by the participant (the suggested size is A3 format or larger). Panels will be made available for displaying the posters.

Applications must be submitted by midnight Monday 10 February 2014.

Notification of acceptance will be sent by email before 5 March 2014.

- Letter of incentive describing your experience in the areas of teaching proposed by the training school, explaining why you are applying and what you expect from the training school in the framework of your current research. Suggested length: 400 to 500 words.
- Attestation from your research advisor or director.
- Curriculum vitae.
- Copy of your student ID card.
